The services include medical services and Behavioral Health services. The primary healthcare services are immunizations, school physicals, sports physicals, sick visits, dental, eye exams and well child checks. There are programs for asthma management, chronic disease management, health education, hypertension management, nutritional counseling, and youth weight reduction.

The Family Health Center at North Clayton High School is a comprehensive medical facility that will serve the following students and staff at the schools below:
